(Sing Verse 1)

(Psalm 55:16-17; 22)

(Sing Verse 2)

"Fear not, for I have redeemed you, I have called you by name, you are mine. When you walk through the fire You will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.

For I am the Lord, your God The Holy One of Israel, your Savior." (Isaiah 43:2-1b, 2b,3.)

(Sing Verse 3)

Do not put your trust in princes, in mortal men who cannot save.

Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob,

Whose hope is in the Lord his God,
The Maker of heaven and earth,
The sea, and everything in themThe Lord, who remains faithful forever.

(Psalm 146:3, 5, 6.)

(Sing Verse 4)

God is our refuge and strength, An ever present help in time of trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way And the mountains fall into the heart of the sea.

The Lord Almighty is with us; The God of Jacob is our fortress. (Psalm 46:1,2b,7)

(Sing Verse 5, congregation reads with team:)

Cast your burden on the Lord, And He will sustain you: He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

(Sing tag: "make us by Thy pow'rful hand...")
